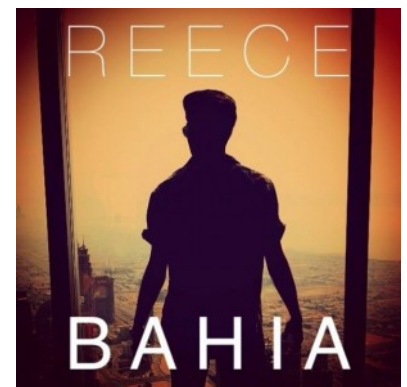

Reece has had the privilege of being given opportunities at further a field events such as Wychwood Festival and was selected by Simon Cowell to be featured on the promo for his Youtube channel "The You Generation".
